High Commissioner-designate to Malaysia calls on President Dr. Arif Alvi

ISLAMABAD; AUGUST 16, 2019: Pakistan and Malaysia enjoy close and fraternal relations based on solid foundation of a shared faith, culture, and cooperation, said President Dr. Arif Alvi, while talking to High Commissioner-designate to Malaysia, Ms. Amna Baloch, who called on him at Aiwan-e-Sadr, Islamabad today.

The President reiterated that Pakistan will never condone the blatant human rights violation in Indian-Occupied Kashmir and will always stand by its Kashmiri brethren. He underscored that all High Commissioners/Ambassadors must highlight the Kashmir issue and Indian oppression in Occupied Kashmir.

Given the high importance Pakistan attaches to its relations with Malaysia, the President urged the High Commissioner-designate to make efforts to further strengthen bilateral relations. He emphasized that efforts should be made to enhance Pakistan's exports through special focus on value added products.
