ISLAMABAD SEPTEMBER 27, 2018: Minister for Commerce and Industry of Kuwait Khaled Nasser Abdullah Al-Rundain called on President Dr. Arif Alvi at the Aiwan-e-Sadr, Islamabad on Thursday. The Minister conveyed message of felicitations and good wishes from the Amir of Kuwait Sheikh Sabah Al-Ahmad Al-Jaber to the President on assuming office. The Commerce Minister of Kuwait is currently visiting Pakistan to attend the 4th Session of Pakistan-Kuwait Joint Ministerial Commission.

President Dr. Arif Alvi, during the meeting highlighted that the longstanding brotherly relations between the two countries are based on close cultural, historical and religious ties.
